## UNDP (UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME)

**United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)** is also known as the **United Nations** global development network. It is primarily concerned with achieving the eradication of **poverty**, reducing inequalities and exclusion, helping developing and least developed countries to formulate policies, leadership skills, partnering abilities, institutional capabilities and building resilience in order to achieve sustainable development according to the **17 Sustainable** Development Goals. **UNDP** is also helping countries to have proper aid utilisation, and also promoting inclusion.

## UNESCO (UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL SCIENTIFIC & CULTURAL ORGANIZATION)

**UNESCO** or United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization, specialised agency of the United Nations that was chartered in a constitution, was signed on **November 16, 1945**. The constitution, which entered into force in **1946**, has the main tenacity to promote international collaboration in the field of Education, Science and Culture. The organisations headquarters are in Paris, France. **UNESCO** has **195** member states and ten associate members. Most of its field offices are 'cluster' offices, covering three or more countries; national and regional offices also exist. **UNESCO's** activities have been primarily facilitative, intended at assisting, supporting, and supplementing the national efforts of member states to eradicate illiteracy and to expand the access of education.







## WHO (WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION)

World Health Organization (**WHO**) is a specialized agency of the United Nations concerned with International Public Health. Its primary role is to direct and coordinate international health within the United Nations system.

Its main areas of work are health systems, health through the life-course, non-communicable and communicable diseases, preparedness, surveillance and response, and corporate services.

## FAO (THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANISATION)

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (**FAO**) is a specialized agency established in **1945** with its headquarters in **Rome, Italy**. **FAO's** mission is to ensure global food security and promote sustainable agricultural practices. It collaborates with governments and organisations worldwide to **eradicate hunger**, improve nutrition, and address challenges in agriculture, fisheries, and forestry. **FAO** plays a crucial role in monitoring food trends, providing research, and contributing to the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals related to **food security** and sustainable agriculture.







## UNICEF (UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S EMERGENCY FUND)

**UNICEF** is a **United Nations** agency responsible for providing humanitarian and developmental aid to children worldwide. The agency is among the most widespread and recognisable social welfare organisations in the world, with a presence in **192** countries and territories.

**UNICEF's** activities include providing immunisations and disease prevention, administering treatment for children and mothers with **HIV**, enhancing childhood and maternal nutrition, improving sanitation, promoting education, and providing emergency relief in response to disasters.

## UN WOMEN (UNITED NATIONS ENTITY FOR GENDER EQUALITY AND THE EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN)

**UN Women**, established in **2010**, is the **United Nations** entity dedicated to advancing global gender equality and women's empowerment. 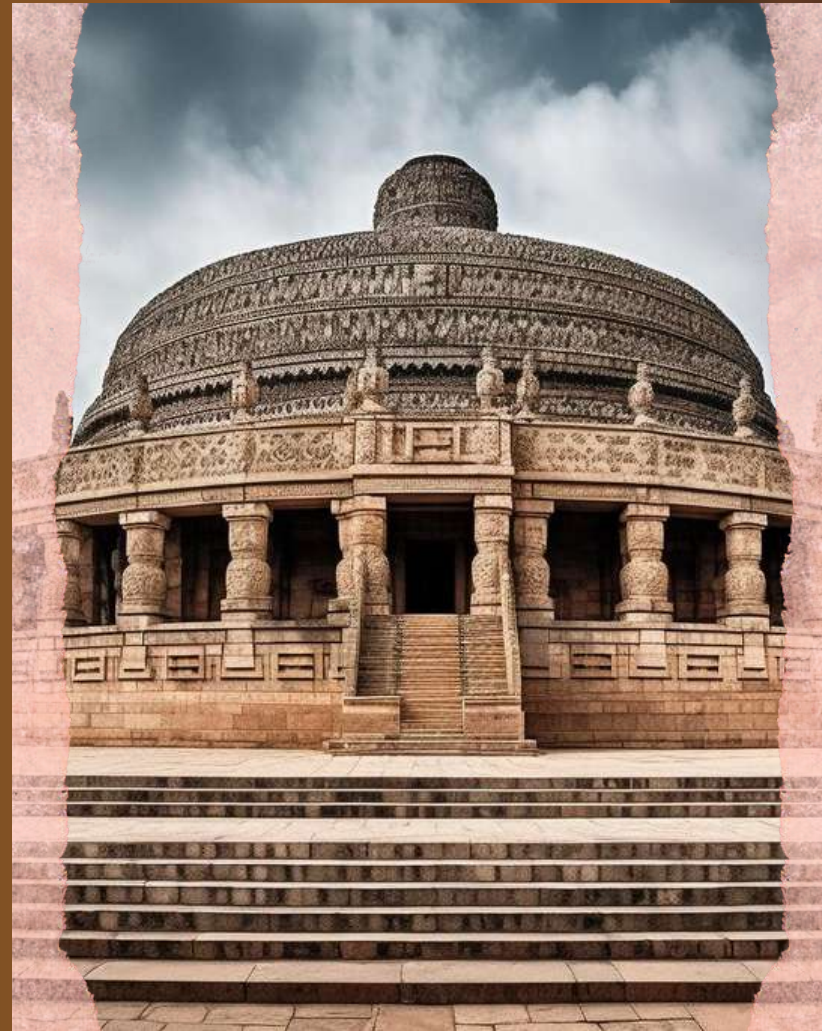
# PARTICIPANTS & VENUE

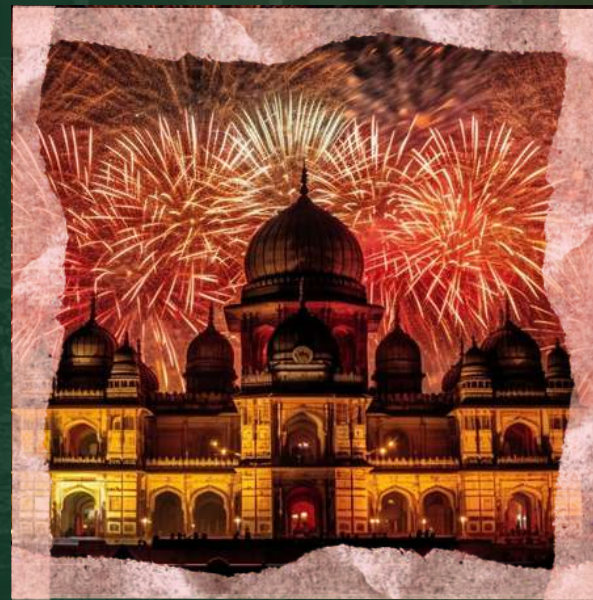
## COMMITTEE SESSIONS

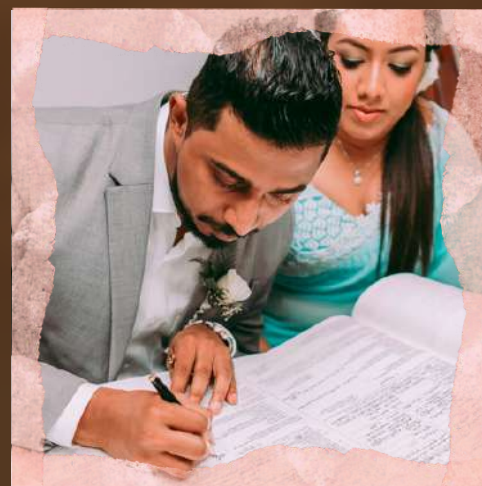


## FULL-TIME LO TEAM

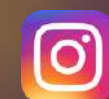
