
Recognized worldwide, IMUN has engaged over 300,000 delegates from 140+ countries through online and offline conferences. In the past 8 years, it has hosted successful editions across Thailand, Vietnam, India, Japan, Egypt, China, Malaysia, Indonesia, and the Philippines, making it one of the premier UN simulations for inspiring globally aware and solution-driven youth.

At International MUN Offline Conferences, we host 10 dynamic committees, each with 2 engaging topics. Participants can select their preferred committee and topic, and are then allocated accordingly. This ensures every delegate engages in debates that truly match their interests and passion.



WHO (WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION)

WHO leads global efforts to ensure health for all. In this committee, delegates will address pressing health issues such as pandemic preparedness, mental health awareness, and universal healthcare access. The discussions will focus on international cooperation, equitable healthcare systems, and building resilient health infrastructure worldwide.

ICJ (INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE)

The ICJ is the UN's principal judicial body, settling disputes between states and advising on international law. Delegates at IMUN act as judges, advocates, and legal experts, debating landmark cases and shaping interpretations of global law.





UNDP (UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME)

UNDP focuses on sustainable development, poverty reduction, and building resilient nations. At IMUN, delegates explore issues such as climate change, economic growth, and inclusive governance, working to create innovative policies for a more equitable and sustainable future.

UNW (UN WOMEN)

UN Women promotes gender equality and empowers women globally. Delegates at IMUN address topics like women's rights, political participation, gender-based violence, and economic empowerment, aiming to shape a fair and inclusive world for all genders.





UNICEF (UNITED NATIONS INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S FUND)

UNICEF advocates for the rights and well-being of children worldwide. In IMUN, delegates discuss topics such as education, child protection, healthcare, and humanitarian aid, developing solutions to ensure every child survives, learns, and thrives.

UNESCO (UNITED NATIONS EDUCATIONAL, SCIENTIFIC & CULTURAL ORGANIZATION)

UNESCO works to build peace through education, culture, and science. Delegates in IMUN debate issues such as cultural preservation, quality education, access to information, and promoting international cooperation in knowledge and heritage.





UNHRC (UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL)

The UNHRC addresses human rights violations and promotes universal rights worldwide. At IMUN, delegates examine issues like freedom of speech, refugees' rights, and humanitarian crises, drafting resolutions that safeguard dignity and justice for all people.

UNHCR (UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES)

UNHCR protects refugees, displaced people, and stateless persons globally. In IMUN, delegates debate solutions for asylum, refugee resettlement, humanitarian aid, and global responsibility-sharing to ensure protection and support for the most vulnerable.





FAO (FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION)

FAO works to defeat hunger and ensure food security. Delegates in IMUN explore challenges such as sustainable agriculture, nutrition, food distribution, and climate impacts on farming, striving to create policies for a hunger-free world.

UNSC (UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL)

The UNSC is responsible for maintaining international peace and security. At IMUN, delegates deliberate on conflicts, sanctions, peacekeeping, and counter-terrorism, experiencing the urgency and high-stakes diplomacy that define real-world global security.



PARTICIPANTS & ELIGIBILITY

At International MUN Conferences, we welcome everyone with a passion for learning, debating, and global issues. While most participants are school and university students, our conferences are also joined by young professionals, teachers, advisors, and observers from around the world. On average, 300–350 delegates from diverse countries attend each conference.

IMUN has no age restriction — because we believe diplomacy and debate depend more on experience and perspective than on age. Everyone, regardless of background, is capable of learning, contributing, and making a difference. To ensure every participant has a meaningful experience, delegates are placed according to their MUN background:

- <u>School Committees</u> for high school delegates
- <u>Beginner Committees</u> for those new to MUN
- Intermediate Committees for delegates with some prior experience
- Advanced Committees for experienced MUN participants ready for challenging debates

This system makes **IMUN** inclusive and beginner-friendly, while also offering **high-level debates** for advanced delegates. Together, this diversity enriches discussions, builds confidence, and fosters lifelong friendships across cultures.

OPENING CEREMONY & Q&A SESSION

The IMUN journey begins with a grand welcome, introductions to the Executive Board and Secretariat, and an overview of the agenda. A live QnA allows delegates to interact with the organizers and clarify any queries before formal sessions begin.



GUEST SPEAKER SESSION

Delegates get the exclusive opportunity to interact with highly qualified speakers from the United Nations, embassies, NGOs, and academia. These sessions provide invaluable insights into global issues, diplomacy, and leadership, inspiring participants to think beyond the committee room and connect with real-world changemakers.



MUN TRAINING SESSION

An interactive workshop led by the Board of Dais prepares participants with MUN procedures, rules of debate, diplomacy, and resolution drafting — ensuring both beginners and experienced delegates are confident for committee sessions.



COMMITTEE SESSIONS

Delegates represent assigned countries in councils of their choice, engaging in real UN-style debates. Through research, negotiation, and resolution drafting, participants tackle pressing global issues under the guidance of experienced Dais members.

The Closing Ceremony marks the grand finale of IMUN, featuring the awards session where outstanding delegates are recognized for their diplomacy, leadership, and contributions. 





EDUCATIONAL CITYTOUR

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- <u>Eligibility</u>: International Model United Nations (IMUN) welcomes applications from high school students, university students, young graduates, and working professionals of all nationalities.
- No prior MUN experience is required.
- Applicants should demonstrate an interest in international relations, diplomacy, or global affairs.

• Registration:

- Registrations are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Once capacity is reached, additional
 applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
- Delegates are advised to register early to secure participation.
- Participation is confirmed only after the completion of payment.

Visa Support:

- IMUN provides official documentation to assist delegates with visa applications upon request.
- Obtaining a valid visa remains the sole responsibility of the participant.
- IMUN holds no liability for visa rejections, delays, or travel restrictions imposed by the host country.
- Travel insurance is strongly recommended.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Cancellation & Refund Policy

- If the conference is cancelled by IMUN, participants will receive a 100% refund of the conference fee.
- Cancellations made by participants are non-refundable, regardless of the reason.
- IMUN does not cover or refund personal travel or accommodation expenses.
- In cases of unforeseen circumstances (natural disasters, political instability, health emergencies, etc.), refunds will depend on reimbursements from venues and service providers.
- Visa rejections do not qualify for a refund.

Privacy & Intellectual Property

- By attending IMUN, participants grant IMUN permission to use photographs, video recordings, and other content captured during the event for promotional or archival purposes.
- All training materials, resources, and IMUN publications are the intellectual property of IMUN and may not be copied, published, or distributed without written consent.

- Code of Conduct: Delegates are expected to maintain the highest standard of professionalism and integrity.
- Information submitted during registration must be accurate and truthful.
- Plagiarism or falsification of documents will result in disqualification without refund.
- Participants must comply with all laws of the host country.

- Discrimination, harassment, racism, bullying, or any form of inappropriate behavior will result in immediate removal without refund and exclusion from future IMUN events.

- Delegates are encouraged to arrange personal travel and medical insurance.
